How to add a gift to your will.



Leaving a gift in your will to Theodora Children's Charity will children across the country to receive a magical and positive Gigggle Doctor visit. Your legacy will have a lasting impact on a child's wellbeing, reducing their stress and anxiety and improving their overall experiences on what can be difficult times in hospital.

What to do next



Consider the type of gift you'd like to leave.

A share of your estate. Also known as a 'residuary legacy', this is a percentage of what remains of your estate after all other gifts and expenses have been paid. This means the charity gift remains in proportion to what they want to leave to family and friends.

A specific sum. This is a gift of a set amount of money, also known as a 'pecuniary legacy'.

A specific item. This could be something of value such as jewellery, a painting, property or shares.

Talk to your solicitor

We recommend that you discuss your will, and the type of gift you might like to leave to Theodora Children's Charity, with your solicitor. The value of your gift to us will be deducted from your estate before Inheritance Tax is applied, so it could reduce the amount of tax paid. Your solicitor will be able to discuss how this may affect your estate and beneficiaries. You can change your mind at any time.
